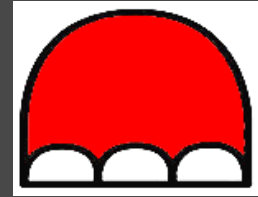
Centennial's New Addition Officially Opens

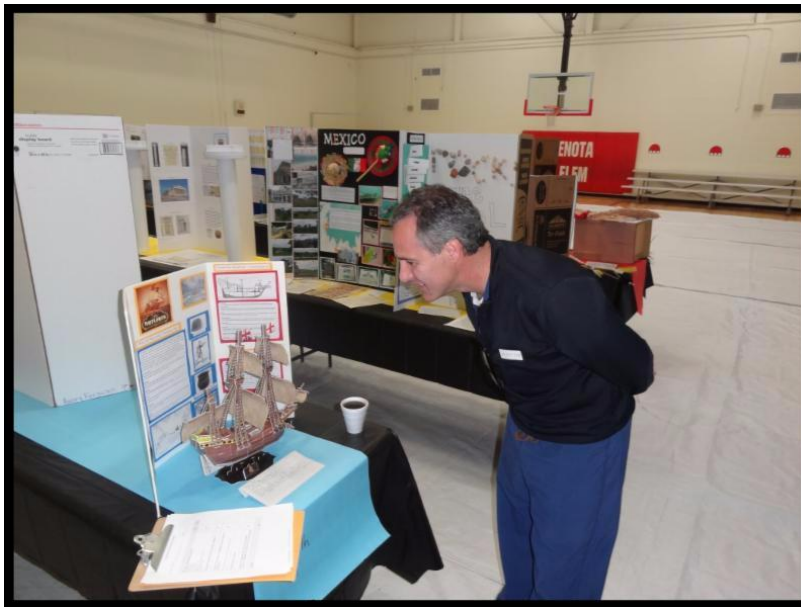

As a respected member of the community, she devotes much of her time and money to serving those who are in need. Her passion for helping others inspires those around her to follow in her footsteps - spreading joy every step of the way.

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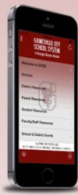

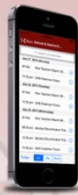


Here are some amazing features to look forward to and things you can do with the GCSS app:
